Waiver of Liability and Negligence Clause

Must be signed by all volunteers, coordinators, and participants

These risks and dangers include but are not limited to extreme weather conditions, extreme physical exertion, faulty equipment, airborne objects, moving vehicles, dogs, or other animals not leashed or out of control as people under the influence of drugs or alcohol. The Participant accepts these risks and dangers.
2. Participant releases from all liability and agrees not to pursue legal action against the Society, it's directors, volunteers, sponsors, agents, and representatives for any personal injury, death property damage, or loss sustained as a result of, or during participation in any Society event howsoever caused including without limitation, negligence on the part of the Society, it's directors, officers, employees, volunteers, sponsors, agents and representatives.
3. The Participant waives all claims they may now and in future have against the Society, its directors, volunteers, sponsors, agents, and representatives.
4. The participants hereby agree to indemnify the Society for any claim loss or action made against the Society by a third party arising out of or as a result of the actions or inactions of the Participant in a Society event or activity.
